



# COMMUTER STUDENT & COLONIAL APARTMENT RESIDENTS

For commuter students and students residing in the Colonial Apartments who would like to partake of meals in the cafes, we offer a prepaid meal card program that will allow you to dine in the Grove City College cafeterias during the school year.

## Here's how the program works:

- 1) Students purchase meal cards at the Bon Appetit business office at Hicks Cafe.  
Hours: Monday through Friday – 9:00am-4:00pm.  
Cards will be available for pick-up within 3 business days from placement of order. Cards will be paid for when picked up... cash or check (no credit cards).
- 2) Prices are based on the non board student meal prices. The prices for the 2006-2007 school year are: Breakfast - \$2.95; Lunch - \$5.30; and Dinner - \$6.55 per meal "All-you-can-eat." (cash price without a meal card: \$3.75, \$5.85 & \$7.40)  
Note: The Sunday Brunch is considered as a lunch meal for this program.
- 3) Cards will be customized to the needs of each individual customer.  
Example: 13 breakfasts, 14 lunches and no dinners.
- 4) Refunds: Refunds will be made based on a 50% value of unused meals. Allow 5 business days for availability of refund for pick-up at the business office.
- 5) Premium Night: Periodically, Bon Appetit has a "Premium Night" in the cafes. This is where a choice between 3 premium entrees is offered during the dinner meal. During these meals, diners are allowed only one premium entree portion. Everything else (including non-premium entrees will remain on an all-you-can-eat basis). When a meal card is used for this meal, there will be an additional \$1.50 charge collected at the door.
- 6) Meal cards will only be valid for the school year in which it is issued, and may only be used when the student board plan is in operation.
- 7) Meal cards are to be presented to the cashier at the front door of the cafe upon entering. The cashier will punch the meal card.
- 8) Meal cards may be used multiple times during any meal period. A meal cardholder may use the card to pay for guests. It is recommended that a cardholder pay cash for children. If a cardholder desires to use the card to pay for a child, one full meal credit will be removed from the card. The program does not have any provisions for child meals.
- 9) Bon Appetit will not be responsible for lost or stolen meal cards. If a lost card is report to Bon Appetit, the name and card number will be posted with the cashier at both cafes in an effort to retrieve it if someone else tries to use it. If the lost card is retrieved, it will be returned to the student who purchased it.

## 2006-2007 Prices:

Prices are based on the non board student meal prices.

*Note: Sunday Brunch is considered as a lunch meal for this program.*

**Breakfast: \$2.95**

**Lunch: \$5.30**

**Dinner: \$6.55**

***For all "Premium Nights" there will be an additional \$1.50 charge collected at the door.***
