

## **INTRODUCTION TO THE MYGCC ACADEMICS TAB**

The 'Academics' tab of myGCC will be your main hub for academic information during your time as a student at GCC. This document will give you a glimpse into a few of the things you can access there.

To begin, log in to the myGCC portal (<https://my.gcc.edu/ics>) and click on the 'Academics' tab from the menu across the top of the screen:

**Let's start with the middle column of the Academics tab.**

### **Courses Schedules**

Add/Drop Courses: This is where you will register for future semesters.

Course Search: Search all the course offerings for a certain term as you plan your schedule out.

### **All My Courses**

This is where you can get a basic view of your class schedule – course and day/time. Be sure the dropdown is set to 'Future Courses' to see your fall 2022 classes.

### **Student Schedule**

In this section you can see a basic view of your schedule. You can also click 'View Details' in this section to get more information about your courses – professor, classroom assignment, etc. If you click the + sign beside a course and then click the "Click here to find textbook information" link, you'll be redirected to the GCC Bookstore website.

### **Grade Report**

This is where you will be able to access your final grades each semester as well as your midterm grades.

## Viewing your unofficial transcript – Language waiver, AP/CLEP/IB credit, Transfer Credits, GCC courses

Your transcript will record all of your academic progress made during your studies at GCC. This includes a language waiver (if received), AP/CLEP/IB credits, transfer credits, and your GCC coursework. It will also record your declared major(s) and any minor(s) or concentration(s) you choose to pursue along with your degree and conferral date when you graduate.

Accessing what is called an “unofficial transcript” can be done by clicking ‘View Unofficial Transcript’ in the ‘Unofficial Transcript’ section of the ‘Academics’ tab (bottom of the center column on that page). Once clicked, a new page will open showing a lot of information in a table-like format. Scroll all the way down to the bottom of this new page and click the ‘GCC Transcript’ PDF link:
