Sociology courses are offered every two years, except SOCI 101, 201, and 251 (offered every semester); SOCI 103 (every fall and every other spring); SOCI 221, 452, 472 (every spring); and SOCI 377 and 471 (every fall). Social Work (SOCW) courses are offered at least once each year with SOCW 209 offered every semester.

Note: No college credits are earned when a student receives a language waiver. When a waiver is earned, the credits currently assigned to foreign language study must be fulfilled through general electives of the student's choosing.
