### WELCOME TO GROVE CITY

#### MATCH NOTES

Grove City hosts Waynesburg this afternoon in both teams' Presidents' Athletic Conference opener at College Field ... The match will help kick off Homecoming Weekend at Grove City.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Grove City earned a 1-1 double-overtime draw at No. 18 Carnegie Mellon last Saturday ... Waynesburg earned a 7-1 win at Cincinnati Christian Monday.

**THE SERIES:** Grove City leads the all-time series 25-2-2 ... The teams first played in 1991.

**LAST MEETING:** Grove City secured a 2-0 win over visiting Waynesburg October 6, 2012 ... Jonathan Rothgeb and Kyle Matherne both scored for Grove City ... The Wolverines earned the program's 500th all-time victory that afternoon.

**GOING THE DISTANCE:** Grove City has played four consecutive overtime matches, starting with the Wolverines' 1-0 overtime triumph over Baldwin-Wallace September 14 ... Six of Grove City's nine matches this year have gone to overtime ... The Wolverines are 2-2-2 in those six matches ... The six overtime matches in one season are the most for Grove City since the 2003 team played seven overtime matches ... Dating back to last year, nine of Grove City's last 14 matches have gone beyond regulation.

**31 FLAVORS:** Waynesburg leads the Presidents' Athletic Conference with 31 goals this season ... The Yellow Jackets also lead the conference in scoring average at 3.88 goals per match ... James Snead and Colin Nelson each have a team-leading six goals for Waynesburg this season.

### WELCOME TO GROVE CITY

**PERFECT 10:** Grove City features players from 10 different states on its 2013 roster: California, Connecticut, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Virginia, Texas and West Virginia.

**THE COACHES:** Mike Dreves is in his eighth season as Grove City's head men's soccer coach ... He is a 1997 Grove City graduate and captained Grove City's 1995 and 1996 squads ... Carl Griffiths is in his second season as Waynesburg head coach.

**ALL-PAC HONOREES:** Two current Grove City players earned All-Presidents' Athletic Conference honors following the 2012 season ... Sophomore forward Seth Loew earned First Team recognition and senior defender Daniel Adams captured All-PAC Second Team honors ... In 2010, current senior Chris Burgan earned All-PAC First Team recognition at goalkeeper.

**TURNING THE CORNER:** Grove City leads the Presidents' Athletic Conference with 78 corner kicks this season, an average of 8.67 per match ... Waynesburg ranks second with 59 corners ... The Yellow Jackets are averaging 7.38 corner kicks per match in 2013.

**AROUND THE CONFERENCE:** This weekend marks the start of Presidents' Athletic Conference play ... Saturday, Thomas More visits Bethany, Washington & Jefferson hosts Westminster and Geneva hosts Thiel ... The top four teams in the conference will qualify for the PAC Championship Tournament.

**ON DECK:** Grove City visits Thiel Tuesday night at 7 p.m. in conference action ... Waynesburg hosts Ohio Christian Tuesday at 6 p.m.
