MATCH NOTES

Grove City opens Presidents' Athletic Conference play this afternoon against Waynesburg as part of Homecoming Weekend on campus.

LAST TIME OUT: Grove City dropped a 1-0 decision at Houghton Wednesday night in non-conference action ... Waynesburg fell to visiting Baldwin-Wallace Tuesday, 2-0.

LAST MEETING: Grove City earned a 1-0 win at Waynesburg October 5, 2012 ... Current senior Sarah Cessar scored the game-winner for Grove City at 61:34 ... Kristi Lathrop stopped four shots to preserve the shutout.

THE COACHES: Grove City head coach Melissa Lamie is in her 21st season with the Wolverines ... She is the program's all-time wins leader, owning a 220-153-28 career record ... She is the all-time winningest coach in Presidents' Athletic Conference women's soccer history ... Carl Griffiths is in his second season as Waynesburg head coach.

CONFERENCE CALL: Grove City is 13-1 in its last 14 Presidents' Athletic Conference openers ... This is the first time since 2006 that Grove City has opened its league schedule against Waynesburg.

SUPER SIX: Six Grove City women's soccer players have earned All-Presidents' Athletic Conference honors during their career ... Current seniors Sarah Cessar and Sam Weber both earned First Team All-PAC in 2012 ... Senior Jessica Heck and junior Kristi Lathrop both earned Second Team All-PAC ... Senior defenders Lydia Caissy and Leah Wilt both earned All-PAC Honorable Mention following the 2012 season ... Cessar and Heck both earned All-PAC Second Team recognition in 2011.
